

PRESIDENT'S COLUMN

SERVICE

Last month, many of us paused to reflect on the life of Senator John McCain, and his commitment to service to our nation. He authored the following, which was published ten years ago (September 11, 2008) in Time magazine:

Every day, people serve their neighbors and our nation in many different ways, from helping a child learn and easing the loneliness of those without a family to defending our freedom overseas. It is in this spirit of dedication to others and to our country that I believe service should be broadly and deeply encouraged.

Senator McCain's recent farewell statement cited to what he termed "America's causes" of "liberty, equal justice, respect for the dignity of all people". I think that regardless of our political affiliation, we can all agree with Senator McCain's belief that these causes should be celebrated and that "service should be broadly and deeply encouraged."

Your First JD Bar Association is committed to fostering the spirit of service to others every year. Among other things, the First JD sponsors Pro Bono and Law Days, in which attorneys volunteer their time at the courthouse to meet with community members who have legal questions. The First JD supports Metro Volunteer Lawyers, an organization that provides free legal services to indigent clients in our District, and Court Support Jeffco, an organization assisting Jefferson County's problem-solving courts. The First JD supports other local charities with grants, which are awarded in years when there is room in the budget to do so. These efforts are consistent with the First JD's purposes as stated in the Bylaws, which include "facilitat[ing] and improv[ing] the provision of legal services to the community . . ." and "administer[ing] the budget for professional, social and community-oriented purposes."

As Colorado attorneys, each one of us took an oath that includes the following promise: "I will use my knowledge of the law for the betterment of society and the improvement of the legal system[.]" We lawyers can (and many of us do) serve in a variety of ways, including taking on matters and clients pro bono publico, serving on charitable boards and committees, and volunteering for Law Day and other community events.
